Stunning model homes open at Jubilee in Sutton

The Windsor Hall offers 3,220 sq. ft. of space with a library, separate living room and dining room, and soaring open to above foyer.

Both models offer private ensuites and Jack and Jill bathrooms, centre islands in kitchens and free-standing oval tubs in master ensuites.

Designed by Toronto-based design firm, Flora Di Menna Designs, the interiors of the model homes are elegant and comfortable, with a calming colour scheme of grays, greens, taupes and warm whites.

Plaster panels for accent walls add interest, depth and texture to the space, with textured accents echoed in kitchen backsplashes and tiled floors.

While the subdued colour scheme carries into the master bedroom, the use of hot pinks, bright greens and blues brings fun and whimsy to children's bedrooms.

Both homes also have finished basements, complete with a family room, games room with pool table and wet bar, and a three-piece bathroom.

In addition to the Haddon Hall and Windsor Hall models, purchasers at Jubilee have a great selection of home designs that include bungalow, bungalow with loft and two-storey designs, with prices starting from \$428.990.

Standard finishes include nine ft. main floor ceilings, tray ceilings in master bedrooms, gas fireplace complete with mantle, a holiday switch for seasonal lighting, cold cellar, and a three-piece rough-in washroom in the basement.

Some kitchens offer centre

islands with breakfast bars, as well as a servery and pantry. All 40' models also come with freestanding oval tubs, and enlarged ensuite showers with a bench. Homes are also ENERGY STAR certified for enhanced comfort and lower energy bills.

Exciting bonus packages include three-inch natural oak hardwood in the family room and level one, luxury granite kitchen countertop, including undermount sink.

Valued at \$2,100, homebuyers receive 12 months of free Rogers service and an exclusive offer discount at the Briars Golf Resort.

Jubilee is just 40 minutes north of the GTA, but with home prices that can save purchasers up to \$400,000.

The quaint shops and restaurants of Sutton's downtown core are nearby, and there is a high school and new elementary school within walking distance.
